- Students will be required to complete an assessment to determine level of literacy and numeracy and undergo an individual interview process to assess suitability prior to acceptance.
- Students following the Part-Time Programme will be required to be employed by a Registered Salon that has a Qualified Stylist in their employ, to be entered into the Part-Time Programme. These students will attend College once a week in Level 2 and 3 and 2 days a week in Level 3 and Level 4.

- All students must be involved in a minimum of 4 community projects involving practical work per annum.
